



Lip Bumper

The lip bumper is used to push the molars on your jaw back to create space for other teeth. The lip bumper consists of a wire which is attached to a molded piece of plastic. You place the wire in the tubes on your lower molars (back teeth), and the plastic piece rests against your lips. When you eat or talk, you push the plastic piece back which pushes on your molars. That action pushes your molars back.

The lip bumper should be worn full-time unless we tell you otherwise. Please make sure you keep it clean. We can show you how if you have any questions.
